

Kondi's Joy, the second book in the *Mysteries in Malawi* series, is a moving story told through the eyes of Kondi Chisale, a young girl who lives in Malawi. Her troubles are seen through her young and observant eyes, which sometimes misunderstand but often see to the heart of matters. They are heartbreakingly true. Though the

book's setting is Africa, Kondi's struggles aren't all that different from what many American children experience. Any child who reads this book will be able to identify with Kondi. There is the perfect amount of danger in the book to keep young people interested but not scare them. And it's through this danger, and her mother's loving example, that Kondi learns to pray, to trust God, and to give her fears to Him. The book is beautifully written. Its descriptions are vivid, and I love the Malawian terms (I don't know the particular African language used) sprinkled throughout. There is a glossary in the back of the book, but even young readers will pick up on the meaning of most words through the context. The author's biography notes that she spent twenty-one years as a missionary in Malawi, and that background is evident in her book. I would have loved Kondi's Joy as a child, and in fact, the book and the whole *Mysteries in Malawi* series is written mainly for young people, but as an adult I loved it!

Kondi is a delightful young girl. I can relate to her desire for her father's love and acceptance. She faced some miserable home conditions, yet still loved her dad. Sylvia Stewart makes Africa and Kondi's family also come alive. I feel I am walking down the dusty road with a load on my head or a child wrapped around me or lying on a mat on the floor with only a blanket over me. I can smell the meal being cooked and enjoy the beauty of the African sky by the wonderful descriptions. I hope to read much more about this young girl who is so brave in the face of many difficulties. Her trust in God is touching. While the book is written for young people, I find it is very interesting for older people as well.

Kondi is a young girl from Malawi, Africa who is faced with many dilemmas at such an early age. One of them, her uncle who has a mean personality and the other is her father, Bamboo, of whom she is trying to win his love. Kondi, although caught between the different problems that arise seems to overcome the situations, with an ending that will surprise you.
