

Les Weatheritt discovered sailing as a deck hand on a 150-foot Caribbean schooner at the age of 21. Back in Britain he taught himself sailing while working as a research economist. He cruised

After a decade in the Caribbean he returned slowly to Europe, spending a year in the Azores.
