

Recommended by my acupuncturist to help me understand the Chinese philosophy of medicine, including our acupuncture sessions and use of herbs.

I've been receiving acupuncture treatment at the local Oregon Chinese School of Medicine (OCOM), and this was recommended by my practitioner. We both agreed that it has the essential information, and makes for a good read; yet, there are times that it appeared a bit too verbose when providing the historical background of Chinese medicine (it went beyond the 'sweet spot'). Then again, there was section that were a bit too technical (I'm just a 'lay person'). Overall, I would still recommend it as an essential read should a lay person warrant the need for 'more', to explain what Chinese medicine is, with the caveat of the aforementioned.

A great comprehensive introduction to Traditional Chinese Medicine. I highly recommend reading the footnotes as you read and taking notes -- there is so much information!

Chinese medicine is a complex subject which presents you not only with the patterns of disharmonies to learn but also with the patterns of confusion to find yourself in. This book takes a

different angle at the subject. I read close to a dozen so far and found it to be a valuable link in clarifying certain concepts. There are other books which are more concrete and clear-cut, however, I found this book to elaborate on certain topics (like Qi, Essence, etc.) in a much more comprehensive manner. It also gives you great critique on different theories (such as 5 Phase theory) that I wasn't able to find in other sources. The language is not your everyday English, it took me lots of trips to the dictionary, as a foreigner, however for an intelligent reader it should not pose a problem. Quite recommend for someone who wants to dig deeper or finds too much confusion in other sources.
