

Bradshaw's was so notable that Dr. Watson, in a Sherlock Holmes tale, uses it to plan where he will go next. This even concludes the original maps. A magnifying glass, unless your eyes are very good, is a recommended accessory. Now if I could just find the Bradshaw's for England and Ireland....
