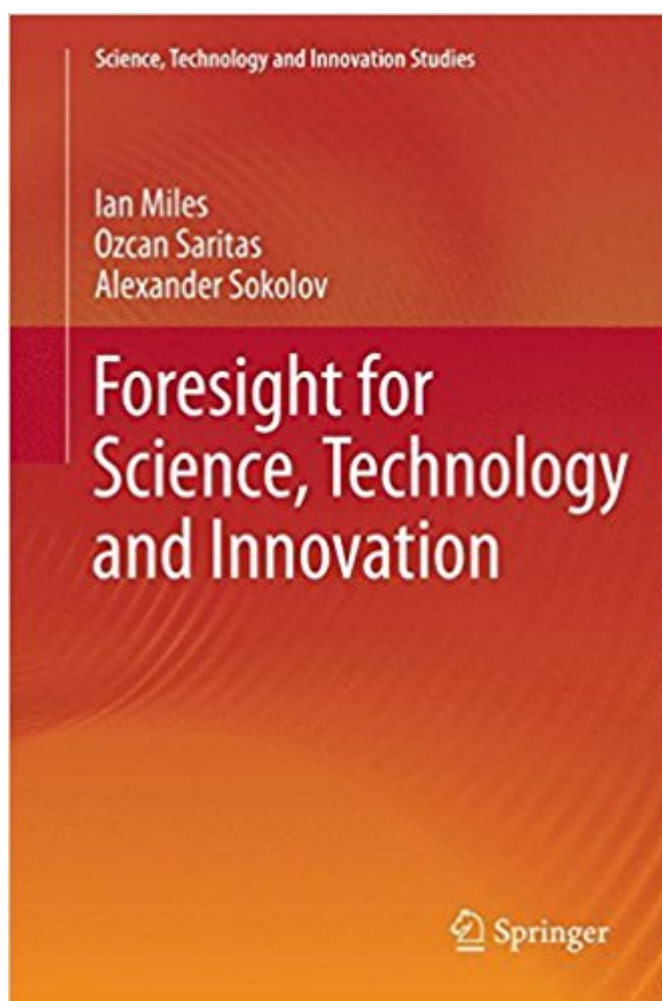


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Foresight For Science, Technology And Innovation (Science, Technology And Innovation Studies)
