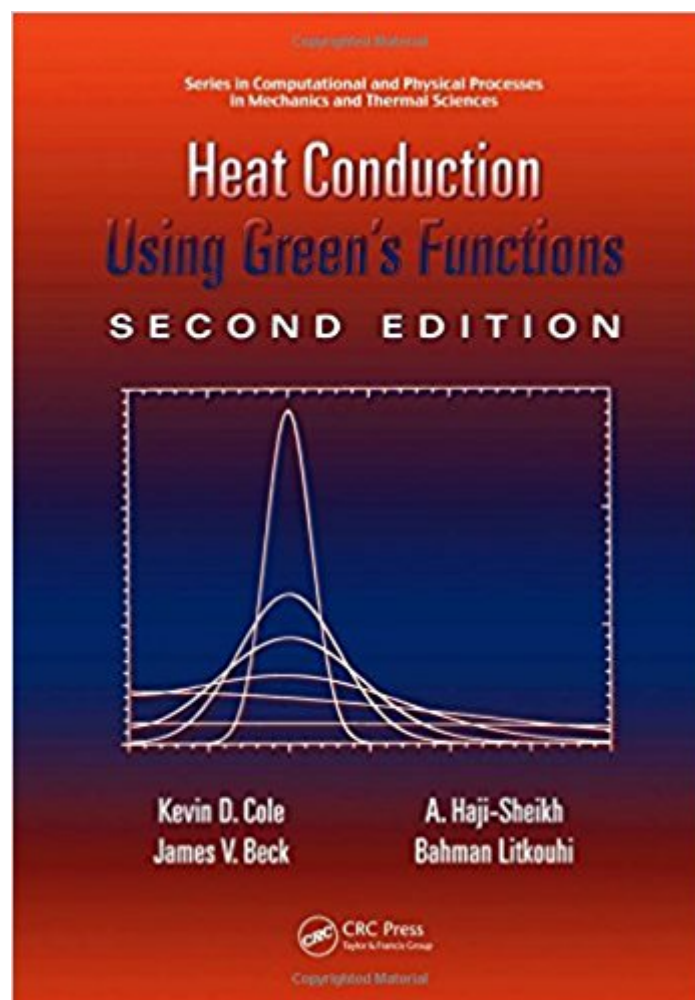


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Heat Conduction Using Green's Functions, 2nd Edition (Series In Computational Methods And Physical Processes In Mechanics And Thermal Sciences)
