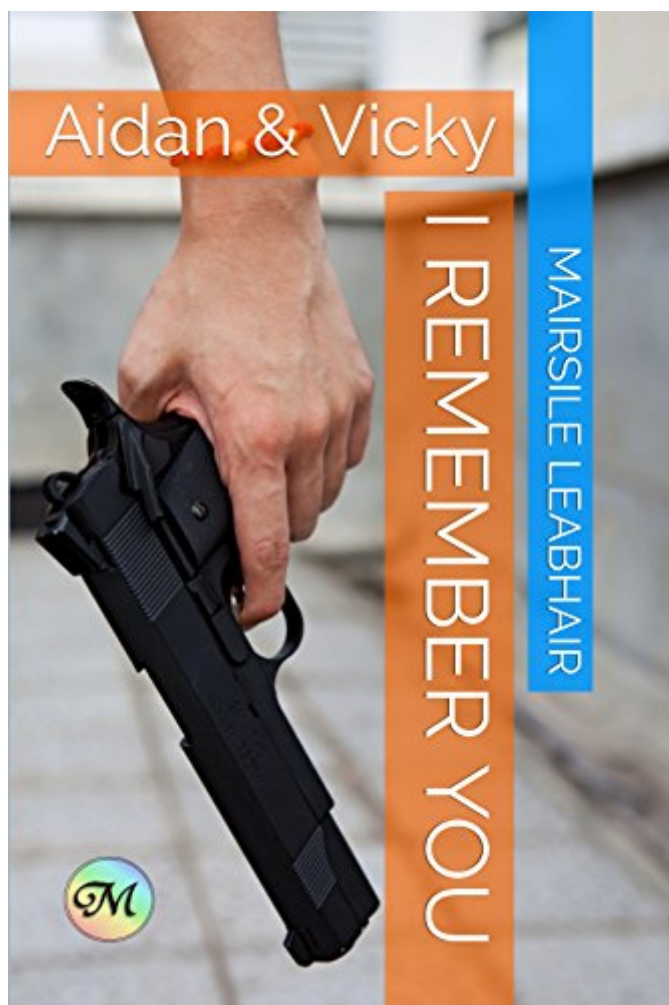

This is the first book I have read of Mairsile Leabhair's. This remind of other series I read. I love the characters and the storyline. I would recommend this book.

This was a really good story, but the continuous misuse of the comma, combined with over-explanations of obvious emotion were incredibly distracting. I've noticed this as an ongoing theme with this writer. It's like she randomly inserted commas and apostrophes to meet some kind of quota. And the changing tenses within sentences made it hard to follow at times. It was also seriously distracting when words were used inappropriately, by supposedly well educated characters. It made them sound wholly ignorant and fake. This could be an award winning series, were it properly edited. I have never been a fan of rushed or hanging love scenes, and this book was full of them! If you aren't comfortable writing a sex scene, then don't write one, don't gloss over it by rushing from kissing to satiated in the span of one sentence... oh! And be prepared for some serious confusion because this author obviously has no idea how to insert a scene break... you will be reading about Aidan and Vicky talking in the lobby, and the next paragraph is the villain's thoughts, and then right back to Aidan and Vicky... this really is a great story and I fell in love with the characters, but please, please, please, Ms. leabhair, get a beta reader, or at least a good grammar editor...

Nice story line but the writing made me roll my eyes so much and drop the book a few times, with sentences starting with "oh,say,why,see"it sounded like a cheesy kids love story, no character development at all, yes they were childhood lovers but at first sight they all kept screaming "I'm so in love", seemed like the writer had to spell every emotion and feeling out to the readers to make sure they got it, for example maybe another writer might say "she felt a tug deep in her chest when she saw Vicky" this writer would say "when she saw Vicky the tug in her chest made her aware that she found her attractive" , there were also so many distracting grammatical errors repeated but I got used to it and fought to Finish the book.Again, good story line but average writing.

The editing of this book was exceptionally poor. How is a book allowed to go to press with this many

errors? The poor editing took away any ability for a smooth reading experience. It clearly impacted the integrity of the story.
