

Grade 5-8-An overview of the country's history, culture, politics, and geography. Shepherd employs a clear and lively writing style, presenting the information within a descriptive narrative. The book is well organized and attractive, with sidebars that amplify or explain points made within the text or photo captions usually on the same or facing page. The full-color photographs are well chosen and appealing. This resource is easy to use, and has a good "Fast Facts" section. Director and playwright Jane Campion's name is misspelled in the text, but that is a minor flaw. Overall, a fine addition to a well-done series.Donna L. In my opinion Donna Walsh Shepherd has penned a premier example of a children's non fiction book. She has lavish illustrations to keep the young people interested. But she also has a huge pile of facts and concepts spread across the 144 page book. Keeping the attention of young readers cannot be said to be easy but I think she does the deed very well. She explains the things in Kiwi society that makes this a unique and different place. She also gives the student a wide background in the history, economy and government of the island nation. By the end the young scholar will hold a life long understanding of New Zealand. Shepherd treats her young readers with respect. This book is aimed at the higher elementary grades and the first year or two of middle school. She does not talk down to the kids but rather expects them to gather and assimilate the large volume of information that she presents.
