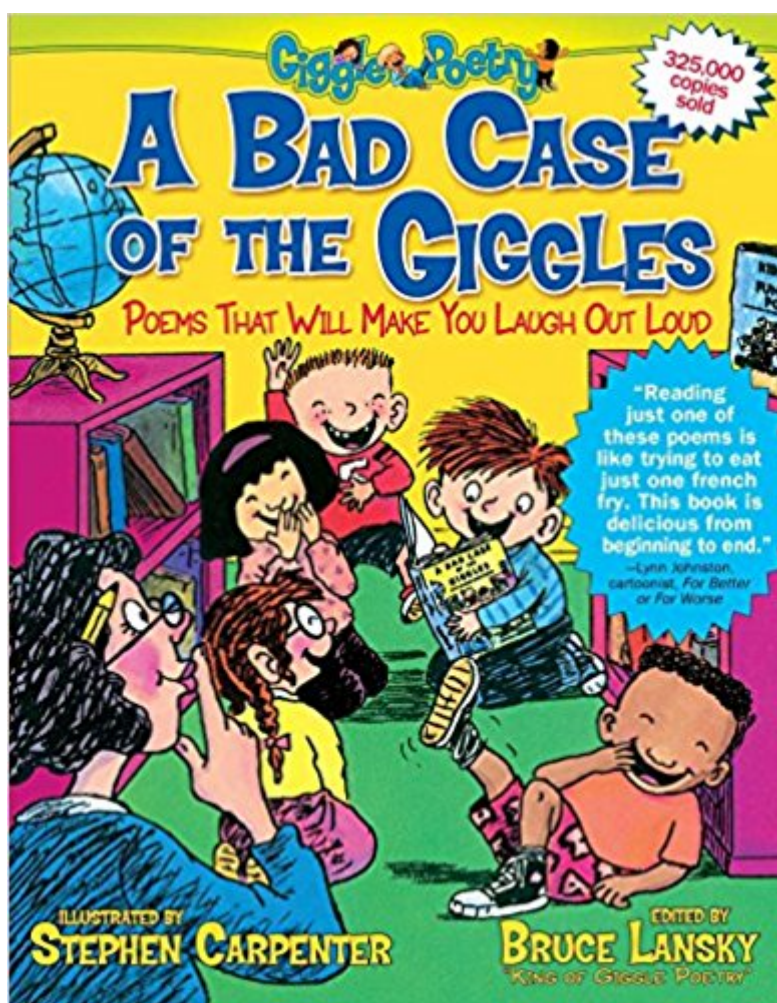

Puns, parodies, slapstick, doggerel, tongue-twisters, and all kinds of nonsense rhymes abound in this large collection of comic verse by favorite children's poets such as Prelutsky, Hoberman, Viorst, Ciardi, and many others. There are lots of poems about eating (including burps and greasy, grimy guts), and about school, family, and bedtime. Everything's physical, from stinky feet to creepy crawlers. The wordplay is funny ("Pick up your room"), and the black-and-white cartoon illustrations express the ridiculous situations and wild exaggeration that will make kids laugh about their world.
