

Great little guide book for an area that's a little 'out of the way' for many travellers. The maps were great, the attractions and hotels recommended were accurate. We spent most of our time in the more rural parts of Flanders, rather than the cities (Bruges, Ghent, Brussels) except for Ypres, where we spent a somber day visiting the WWI sights and cemeteries. As I said, it is a great book, but I would give this book a 5-star rating just for its recommendation of the Hof ter Doest in Lissiwege, just north of Bruges. If we could only go back to one place on our trip, which included Reykjavik, London and Paris, this would be the place.
