

Yes the book has some dirty signs but not the whole book. It has pick up lines, bodily functions signs, sports and just everyday talking, like feeling crappy, let's grab a drink. The demonstrations are not that clear to read and will need to

carefully look at. It's a good book to have in your library of sign language if the cover bothers you than just cover it. I would suggest that you purchase it used still in very good condition.

This actually turns out to be a handy aid. Not only does it give you the "dirty words" and phrases, but when you read it, you realize there is a need to be careful how you sign normal, non-dirty words and phrases. It turns out some words that we learn in informal, conversational ASL classes can easily be mis-presented or mis-formed as a dirty word or phrase. I recommend this book for those learning informally (conversational classes, books, DVD's, etc) and for those who may be teaching friends or family members. A parent that's trying to teach a child or one person teaching friends some basic ASL might want to read this book and keep it nearby. Aside from all of that, the book provided me some useful examples of some normal, conversational phrases in context and easy to understand. This is really a pretty good book once you get past the title and humorous intent.
