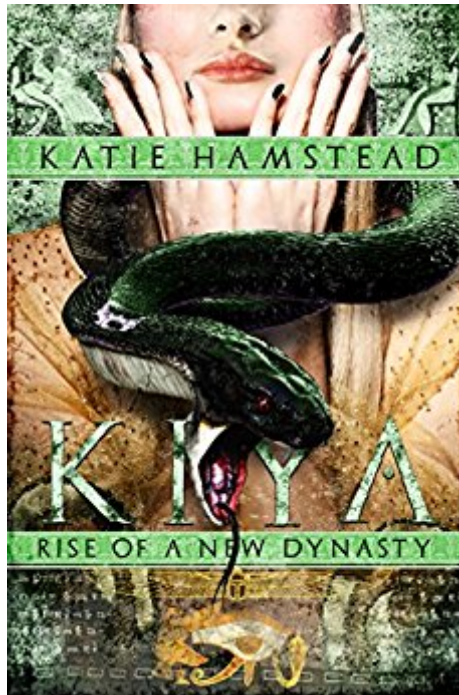




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KIYA: Rise Of A New Dynasty (Kiya Trilogy Book 3)
