

Synopsis

Businessman Mark Ireland's father was Richard Ireland, a deeply spiritual minister and renowned psychic and medium who counted Mae West among his famous clients. I enjoy reading books on life-after-death which combine research and evidential criteria with personal experience. Mark Ireland's background, having grown up with a celebrated clairvoyant and medium for a father, is almost as fascinating as the uplifting after-death communications he experiences in his quest to stay connected with his beloved late son Brandon. Some reviewers felt parts of the book were boring to read. The author gave a little insight on the quantum physics involved, which may not be interesting to everyone, and he shared philosophical shifts he encountered transitioning from a businessman to a spiritual seeker and author, which may have not been as engrossing to some readers as the rest of the material presented in his book. While these portions were not as engaging as learning about his father, Richard Ireland, or reading accounts of his visits with mediums such as Allison DuBois, these sections are easily skimmed over if not of interest. Overall, this book is well-written and makes a worthy contribution to the growing archives of life-after-death material.
