The author lays out a strategy that will prepare you for starting your own publishing business offering services to authors from editing to website design to publishing. I found this book very inspiring and useful in exploring how to develop the skills needed to become an editor-through online classes, or physical classes, or by reading books such as the Chicago Manual of Style and going through exercises in editing workbooks to hone your skills. Dustin Schwanger gives real world views on the pros and cons of being an editor, how to receive training, getting initial experience, getting work from publishers, your marketing toolkit, networking-plus additional details. He gives recommendations on books and classes to get started right away. I enjoyed reading how he accomplished his goal to become a freelance editor and like his enthusiasm for his work. It is very inspiring to me. I recommend this book to others who aspire to become an editor-you will see a clear path paid out before you!
