

Most recently, Windsor researched the disparate regulation of transgender and cisgender consumers of surgical body modification. Elisabeth O. Burgess is the director of the Gerontology Institute and an associate professor of gerontology and sociology at Georgia State University. Her research interests focus on changes in intimate relations over the life course, including involuntary celibacy, sexuality and aging, and intergenerational relationships. In addition, Dr. Burgess writes on theories of aging and attitudes toward older adults.

I purchased this book for a Sexuality and Culture topical seminar I took in college. Less of a textbook and more of a collection of viewpoints from many diverse writers, it is an illuminating read for persons who are wanting to expand their knowledge into many different topics dealing with sexuality, gender, and culture. It is a bit tedious at times with some of the writings but overall a decent read that I would recommend.

This is a textbook. Packed with case studies written in an interesting format, it informs the uninitiated about nearly every sex- related issue.
