

The batteries were dead when I got it. They are expensive to replace. After reading through it I realized that the children this is geared to will know nothing but cell phones. They will need to unlock a key pad before dialing.

The book was listed as Good condition but it was anything but. The dial buttons didn't work and there's no way to change the battery w/o breaking apart the book. Oh well.

In my opinion every child should have this book. I first saw it on a talk show on TV and the child saved his mother life because of this book. My grandson is 16 months old and I just started to introduce this book to him. He finds it a little loud but it getting use to it. My nephews who are 2 and 4 love this book. I got the book and when I sat down with my son to read it, we were both dissapointed to find there was no sound to it. I am unable to figure out how or even if I can change batteries. Needless to say, it is now sitting in his room in a pile of books that are never picked up. I guess I will have to look for another.

Everyone wants to teach their young child to use 911 in case of emergency but not to scare or traumatize the small children by talking about emergency situations. This book has just the right attitude to help you show your pre-schoolers when to dial 911. It has become a favorite that is always laying around in view. They love being able to actually dial 911 on the 'phone' keypad. They only get the sirens if they dial correctly, so they learn to do that rather quickly. I would definately recommend it for ages 2 to 6.

This book is fun and teaches many different ways and situations where kids would need to call 911. The only problem I have with it is that it is very LOUD. Otherwise, it is great. When you push other numbers other than the correct ones it makes a sound that sounds like when you make an error with a Microsoft application. My 4 1/2 year old loves it. I am sure she would have been great with it when she was a little younger too. Great choice of book to help teach our kids what needs to be done in an emergency.
