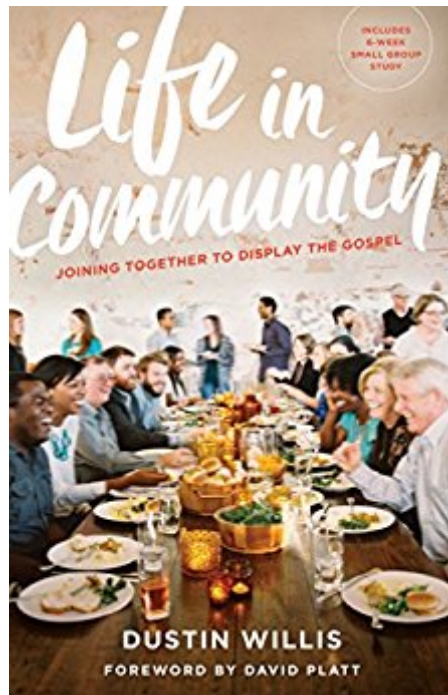




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Life In Community: Joining Together To Display The Gospel

are overly used in Christian circles, Dustin presents for the reader a clear call for community within the context of mission. Life in Community lays a compelling foundation for the theological reasons why the Christian life without community is an enemy to the gospel while consistently showing practical ways to live in community. The greatest contribution to the church has to be Chapter 5: No Masks Allowed. In this chapter, Dustin urges the reader to the value of coming clean in community. He shows how the gospel frees us to actually live in community not a theater of performers. He writes. "The depth believers experience with one another is linked directly to their level of honesty." This is a must read for every pastor, small group leader or ministry leader. In fact, the body of Christ needs to read this book.

"Life in Community" gives us a picture of the kind of church that each of our home churches needs to be today.
