This set of Pixar postcards is very, very nice! Out of 100 postcards, no repeats. The cards themselves are made out of nice heavy card stock,... not cheap and flimsy. The pictures are great! There are a few that to me are just 'meh' but I would say out of 100 there are only 5 or 6 pictures I thought were so-so, the rest I love! It will be hard to send some of these out! For the Pixar collectors, this is a nice set and they arrive in a really cute storage box. The box I received had a slight dent on one side, but for the most part it looks pretty good. I love Pixar movies and these postcards are really cute, happy with my purchase! :)

I got these to use for corresponding with our 5 year old grandson. He lives on the west coast of Florida and we live on the east coast. We write a letter and enclosed a self addressed stamped postcard from the amazing collection in the box. Then, his parents help him read the letter and write

us a post card. It was the easiest for them and we want to let him know we miss him. I also remember how much I used to love snail mail and pen pals. Hopefully, we will be able to maintain his interest, or capture it. The postcards are helpful because they are geared to his age.

These postcards are beautiful! The artwork of Pixar has always appealed to me and these cards are printed in the same bold colors as the films. One of my favorite things about these postcards is that they are printed on a heavier cardstock than most postcards I've bought before. I'm confident that mailing them won't result in bent, folded, or otherwise destroyed results, meaning that my card-and message-will be more likely to reach their destination unharmed.

I bought two sets of these postcards, one to use and one to add to my collections. These are very durable cards with lots of illustrations from Toy Story, some from CARS and the rest from other PIXAR movies. This is a great set to add to a collection from any of the PIXAR movies. They are also fun to send to people as postcards. And the box they are in is also very collectible, or use it to store small items. The PIXAR illustrations on it are delightful.

It's a decent value, 100 sturdy postcards for around \$13. These are not printed on cheap paper like most post cards. Seriously, it's as if they knew that to get a person to spend \$13 on postcards, they better be able to handle some actual wear and tear. They come in a nice looking box, loose. If you're looking for postcards to use in the mail, these are excellent. As I said before, they're printed on sturdy card stock. The images used are stills from the films or sketches of characters and scenes from the films during the planning stages, and a handful of pictures that look like they were drawn by children. Great stuff, honestly. I purchased these to use as postcards, especially since it's kind of hard to find postcards out here. It can be done but the choices are slim. I like to send the occasional post card to my preschool students to encourage them to use the postal service and send along a little cheer (who doesn't like getting a postcard?), so I sought these out with that purpose. I would recommend these for anyone who enjoys Pixar art, who wants to collect these for just looking at and/or wants to have a supply of high quality postcards on hand.

These are awesome. I bought them to put in my sons bedroom. He needed something on a large empty wall but I didn't like the idea of having frames on every wall space and I already had cool

cartooney outer-space stick ons on two of them. I taped them directly on the wall 6 across and 5 down spaced about an inch apart. It doesn't match the theme of the rest of his room but they are fun and cute and look really cool the way I put them up. I have a whole box of extra so I mail them to my nephew who lives across the state every couple of weeks. They are a really great deal and you can glue them to blank card stock to make cards for other kids birthday parties.

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
