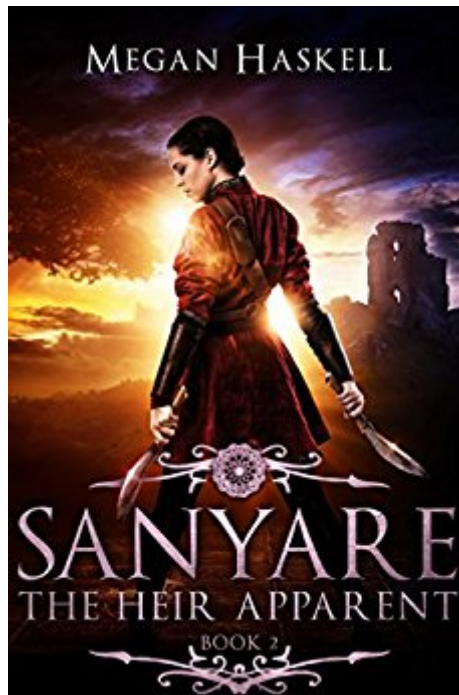




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Sanyare: The Heir Apparent (The Sanyare Chronicles Book 2)

When assassins try to kill her, she is saved by Daenor, but the 3 are killed immediately by his sister that has been removed as heir to his shadow kingdom. She escapes and Daenor is held as a political prisoner until Rie can prove he had nothing to do with the deaths. As she races through the realms to catch her, she is aided by a friend/betrayer and a mythical animal. Deception goes further than a soul stealer. Political machinations, her powers are erratic, and very few want her to take up the mantle of Sanyare because she is human, not fae. The treaty is in jeopardy, there is a underground revolt to take out the leaders of all the realms. No one will listen. Escape is the only answer.

Loved book one and was anxious to read the next installment in this excellent series. I love this series, and the books never seem long enough-- sigh. Some good progression on the overall story line, but there is still more to come-- and I can't wait. This installment of the Sanyare Chronicles explores Rie's doubts about her worthiness to Apprentice to the Sanyaro. After a century under the High Elves' thumb, Rie finds herself having trouble manifesting her (proven) powers. Book two seems to explore how self-doubt can prevent us from growing into our potential. Another wonderful story in this series, and I'll be eagerly awaiting book three.
