

When I read this book, it was really easy to relate to Marks' experiences. His personality and disposition are similar to my own minus a beautiful wife, a plethora of close interactions with many different people, and probably no past blunt head trauma or brain injury. Can Dianetics (Scientology) help in succeeding in life? Perhaps. Maybe if u don't get the wrong end of the stick. Given that the Hierarchy of Dianetics is all White anyone else of colour would probably not fare as well. Plus the whole pseudo religion of Dianetics revolves around one man L. Ron Hubbard who was creating the whole of the Dianetics universe on the fly literally making stuff up as the years rolled by apparently. If u are destitute and broke, then Dianetics can be a legitimate way of life albeit a harsh life with very little creature comforts unless u are up near the top of the food chain. The Biggest problem with Dianetics is the amorphous concept of the state of Clear. Apparently, this can go on forever without any resolution to the detriment of the individual involved in the process. The monetary outlay for this ridiculous condition is outrageous to say the least. A billion year contract contradicts the need to clear the planet with any eminency. Unless it is to satiate current creature desires of certain individuals. The contrast between Dianetics and the word of God is striking. One is a closed book while the other is an open book. I just bought the Kindle version of this book but of course I have been hearing about this a lot for the past year or so, and have been meaning to get a copy. I've heard a great deal about the latest insights in to what takes place inside the criminal enterprise over the past 10, 15 years, yet here we have details collected and placed in to one location by a well-placed eye witness. I do consultant

work within the law enforcement arena, and getting some of these Scientology ringleaders and crime bosses put in prison has been difficult only due to the lack of funding. It takes a lot of money to put top-tier organized crime figures behind bars, and to roll-up the entire Scientology crime syndicate from top down would literally require Congressional funding in the United States. What these public exposures in the form of books, magazine articles, news reports, spotty felony indictments, and the seemingly endless parade of civil lawsuits against Scientology's fraudulent fake fronts (such as their NarCONon frauds) does is they help to make law enforcement's job easier. The information provided in this book is used by law enforcement agencies, prosecutors, and plaintiff attorneys. Eventually we will eliminate the Scientology crime syndicate entirely, its ringleaders either put in prison or hiding out in third world countries with difficult extradition treaties, if any. Marc Headley has written a stunning exposé on the human trafficking, abuse and trauma that occurs in Scientology, all from David Miscavige's narcissistic, psychopathic totalitarian rule, modeled after L.
