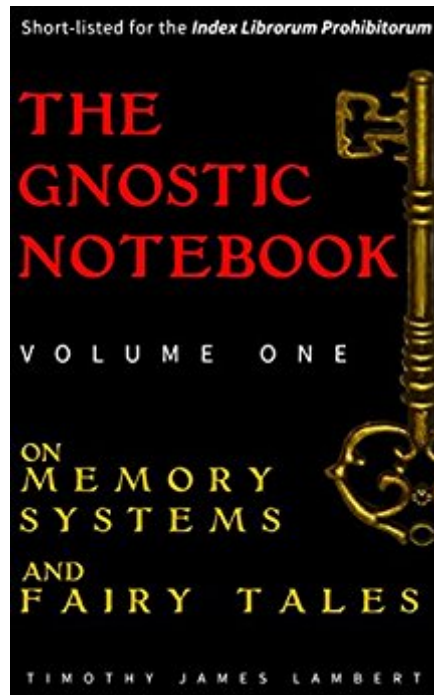


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The Gnostic Notebook: Volume One: On Memory Systems And Fairy Tales



Synopsis

If the fairy tales of the Brothers Grimm are nothing more than written records of oral folk tales, how is it that some contain sophisticated forms of encryption? Why were some fairy tales constructed in accordance with the Ad Herennium, an ancient Latin text containing the earliest recorded instructions for the creation of memory systems? How does one explain the fact that the Ad Herennium's instructions mirror one of the key images from the synoptic Gospels, the scourging of Jesus? Could it be that the Gospels' authors were actually skilled practitioners of the Art of Memory, who utilized that system within the Gospels for the secret encryption and storage of information? And how is all of this connected to the millennia-old conflict between the two oldest traditions of Gnostic Christianity, those of John and Thomas? The Gnostic Notebook is a fresh examination of several classic texts in a search for hidden layers of meaning. The meanings are unlocked through a series of easy to follow steps, using a variety of steganographic and cryptographic techniques. The messages decrypted are not the usual esoteric or Freudian interpretations; rather they contain actual, undeniable information encoded into the texts ages ago. Their existence challenges everything we thought we knew about these texts, including our basic understanding of the Bible itself!

I thought it was interesting to see the various fairytales being opened up like this. I didn't even know what steganography meant before this. So I found this book both easy to read and very informative. The sort of inner secrets being revealed from them was a real trip. Vol. 1 of the Gnostic Notebook focuses on establishing an argument that classical texts (including possibly sacred scripture and religious texts, but the author makes his case using stories collected by the Grimm brothers) were encrypted using various keys in order to hide hidden messages for those who knew how to find them but often go unnoticed by those who don't. These keys are similar to the ways that "Memory Palaces" were systems (often creating striking or visceral visual images that relate to key ideas) devised for ancient readers to memorize & visualize long passages of texts that would seem almost impossible to us now but explain the almost superhuman abilities of ancient orators to recite whole texts while many modern humans can hardly remember a handful of passwords and phone numbers. The book shows how "fairy tales" weren't just odd tales pushing obtuse moral messages but in fact conceal deeper truths if one knows the keys that reveal what has

been hidden. The book discusses two main keys (Gurdjieff's Triads and the hexagrams of the I Ching) and using them to decode several different passages from the Brothers Grimm. Anyone interested in alchemy, symbolism, the subconscious or even literary criticism might find the application of the keys presented useful in decoding texts, artwork, religious icons, films or perhaps even dreams. I'm fascinated to see what future volumes in the series contain.

Well, what do I make of this book? I thought it would be about the bible and uncovering secrets in the bible. The book does promise you that but then it also tells you that you have to go through the methods the author has thought of and figured out on his own to decode the Gnostic messages. So I think, you as a reader should read this book before attempting to read the other books in this series. It gives you all the information you need to get a better grasp of the setting and the even the idea of secret messages. Kudos to the author for coming up with a book like this. I
