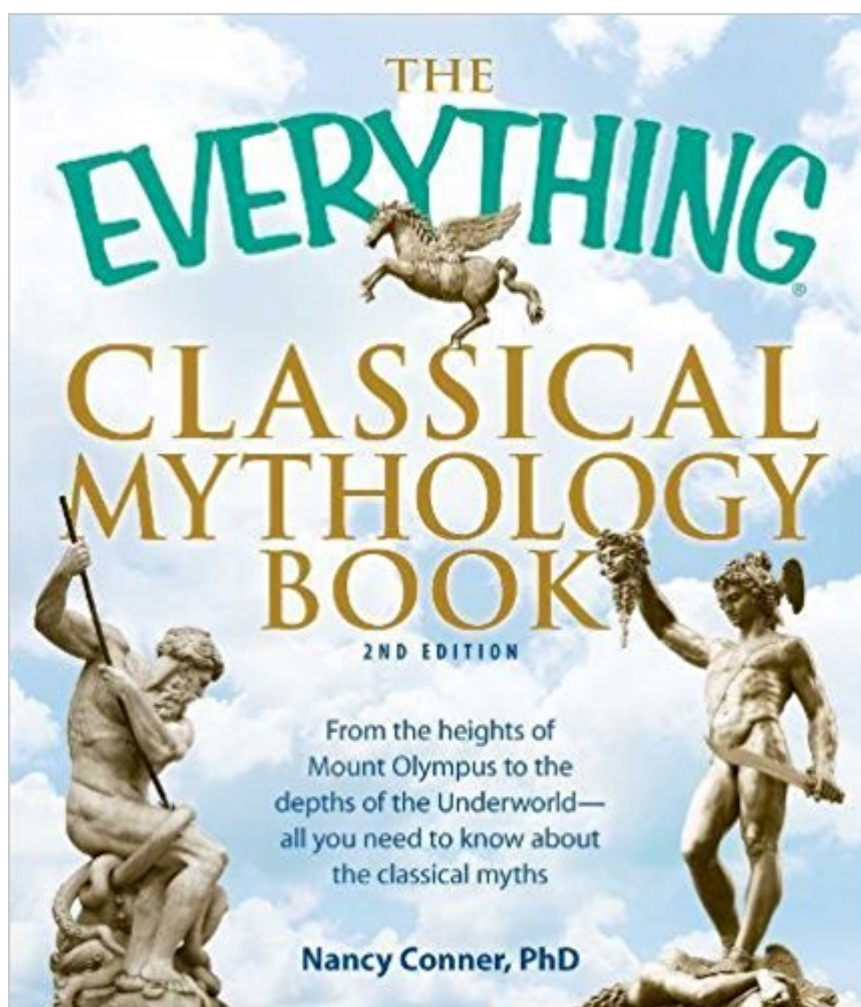


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The Everything Classical Mythology Book: From The Heights Of Mount Olympus To The Depths Of The Underworld - All You Need To Know About The Classical Myths

I used to think, who in the heck would want to read a Kindle book on their iPhone? But then I realized that on those occasions where a reader finds herself utterly "stuck" for some reason, it is the best idea ever. I decided to put this book on my phone to read to my younger son when we are waiting on the rest of the family to meet up with us (which happens a lot). We haven't finished it yet, but it's well-written and interesting, and the perfect book to read in spurts. I hadn't found another "all classics myth" book that fit the bill, and this one does. There are actually several discussion levels to each phase of the book, which you can skip or indulge, depending, and it's a little deeper than you might expect given the fluffy cover.

A good reference source from creation to the fall of Troy written in a modern narrative. Each section is highlighted in bold print for quick and easy access. There are also grey boxes that offer additional information on the characters, facts, vocabulary words or poems associated with the Gods and Goddesses. A family tree of the Greek Gods and a cast of characters is also included. However, if you are looking for something beyond 'the basics' as I was, this book probably wouldn't inform you of anything you haven't already read. On a positive note, this would make a good first book for students or anyone else interested in learning about Greek Mythology.
