

This is a VERY thorough and wide-ranging introduction to the American Arts and Crafts movement. It also contains material on the English A&C movement, which preceded it. Mostly what one hears of today is the Mission style, and it was fascinating to learn of the many other versions, too. I don't really care for the A&C revival stuff going on nowadays. The modern homes don't quite "fit" with the period A&C furniture and decorations. It reminds me of a relative of mine, who lives in a modern, executive-style McMansion--filled to the brim with Victorian antiques. Clash, clash, clash! The Timeline at the beginning of the book is especially useful, as is the long list of resources at the back

for those who want to design or decorate in the Arts and Crafts style. And as other reviewers have noted, the book covers the whole U.S. Arts and Crafts lovers are well familiar with the famous dictum of William Morris: "Have nothing in your home that you do not know to be useful or believe to be beautiful."
